Guidelines for the Abstract Submission Process

The World Hepatitis Summit

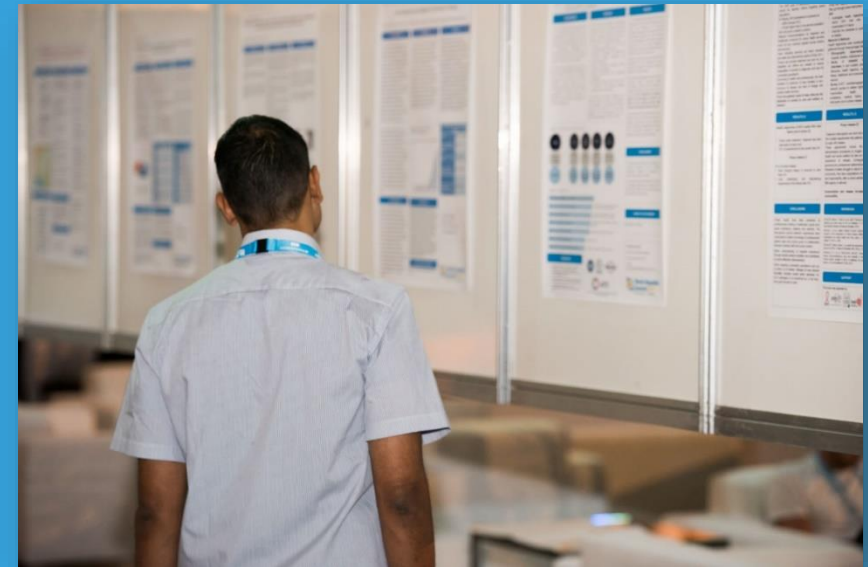
- The summit **programme** will feature speakers working across the cascade of care at global, regional and national levels. The programme will be abstract-driven thus ensuring that those who are working on innovations in technology and service delivery are given a platform to share their experiences.
- We therefore invite you to submit your abstracts showcasing your work.

Abstracts will be reviewed and will be chosen :

for both an oral and poster presentation

or

only as a poster



WHS Abstract Submission Process

- ✓ All abstracts must be in **English**
- ✓ The submissions will be done **online**
- ✓ Your abstract cannot exceed **3000 characters** and your abstract title cannot be more than **100 characters**
- ✓ You must select **one category** to submit your abstract against
- ✓ You may submit **more than one** abstract. One online submission is required for each abstract
- ✓ The **same abstract cannot be submitted** in various categories/topics
- ✓ **Edits to submitted** abstracts may be made up to the submission deadline

WHS Abstract Submission Process

The abstract submission topics are the following:

- **Innovations - in technologies and/or service delivery, including integration, decentralisation, task-shifting, simplification and community led initiatives**
- **Advocacy, awareness and education campaigns**
- **Combatting stigma and discrimination**
- **The power and impact of lived experience**
- **Prevention of mother to child transmission of viral hepatitis and hepatitis in children**
- **Developing and implementing elimination plans (national, state or local level)**

WHS Abstract Submission Process

- **The role of good data, surveillance, monitoring and evaluation in elimination**
- **Hepatitis and Covid-19 – impact and opportunities**
- **Partnerships (Private/Public, Cross-sectorial)**
- **Financing for viral hepatitis (including investment cases and financing models)**
- **Universal Health Coverage and person-centred approaches**
- **Health disparities, health equity & key populations (e.g. PWID, MSM, refugees, indigenous populations)**

STEP 1

- Go to <https://www.worldhepatitissummit.org/> and click on the top menu bar to go on the abstract submission page



WHS Abstract Submission Process

STEP 1 cont.

- You will be directed to the submission platform to create an account
- An email will be sent from MCI for you to verify your account

Abstract Submission

WHS 2022

- › The online submission system will guide you through the submission of your abstract.
- › Abstracts must describe original, previously unpublished work.
- › Scheduling of poster sessions and abstract presentations is at the discretion of the Scientific Committee. Abstracts will be organized into sessions using the topics chosen by the submitter in the online system.
- › You are disconnected after 30 minutes of inactivity. **Please be aware that the system is only active when pressing on “next” or “save”.** Typing is NOT considered as being active.

- You can only choose **one category per abstract**
- You also have to choose up to **3 key words** which will be incorporated in your abstract. Keywords are used in order to facilitate the review process and to allocate abstracts which have been chosen to present at the summit into the relevant sessions

STEP 4

Writing of your abstract


The structure of your abstract must be in 5 sections and should incorporate:

- ✓ **Background**
- ✓ **Objectives**
- ✓ **Methods**
- ✓ **Results / Outcomes**
- ✓ **Conclusions / Lessons learnt**

WHS Abstract Submission Process

STEP 4 cont.

- There will be space provided for you to fill in each section
- The abstracts should not exceed **3000 characters** and you will be able to see your character count on the top right hand side of the page
- You will also be able to upload a maximum of **two (2) files** – these could either be tables, charts, graphics or images/photos - this is not a requirement

STEP 4 cont.

- Once you complete all the sections, you will be asked to **review, finalise and submit your abstract**
- Upon submission, you will receive a **confirmation email**
- **Edits to submitted abstracts** may be made up to the submission deadline. Instructions for making edits can be found on the submission site.
